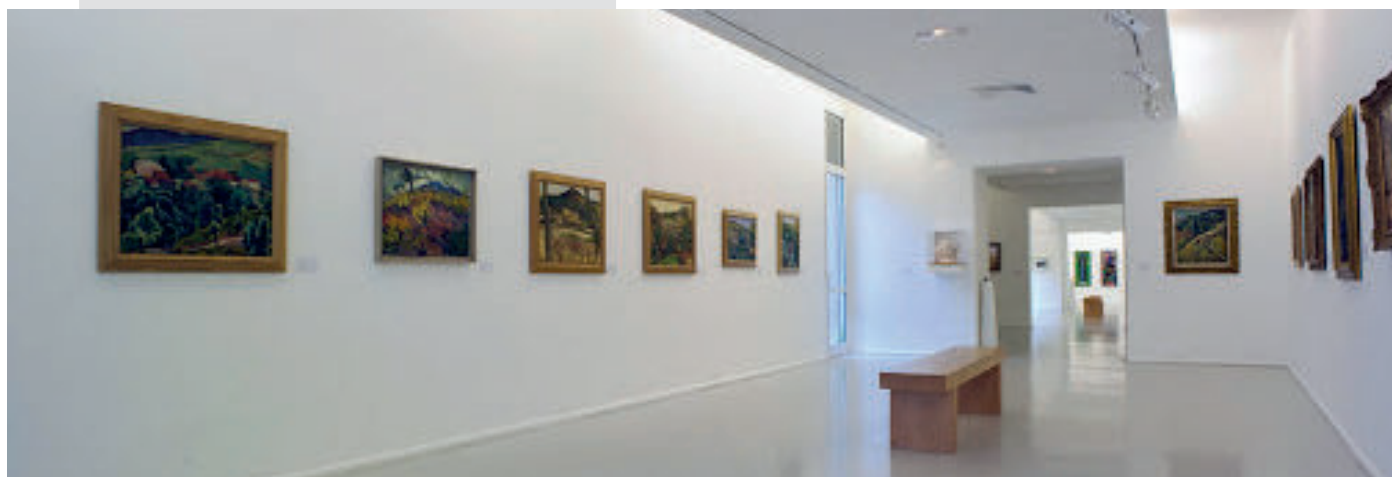

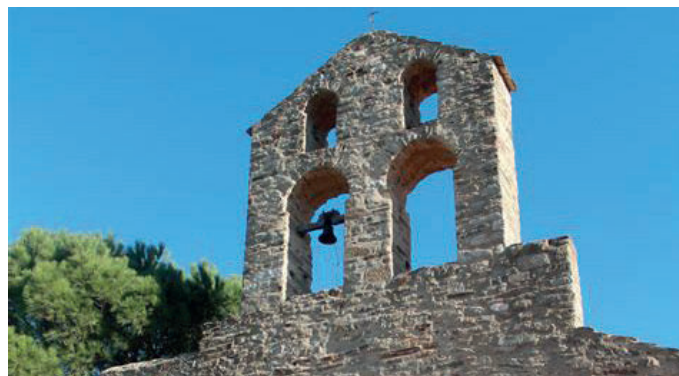

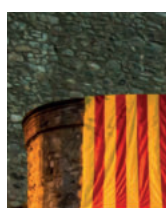
THE ANCIENT SITE AND THE ST NAZARI CHURCH OF LES CLUSES HAUTE

The site of Les Cluses is a border post that carries the traces of the passages from Antiquity to the present day. Along the river of Rome, the *Via Domitia* is dominated on one side by a Roman fortress dating from the 2nd century, and on the other, the *Castle of the Moors* dates from the 4th century. In between, the portium allowed the control of goods from the border. These remains have been classified as *Historical Monuments* since 2010. In the Middle Ages, a castle and a church were built on the remains of the Roman fortress. This church is dedicated to Mary and then to Saint Nazari. The frescoes are a unique example of 12th-century murals in the territory, very similar, in style, to the chapel of Sant Martí de Fenollar (Morellàs).

DID YOU KNOW ?

Sardana is a traditional Catalan dance. The dancers form a circle while holding hands and compose specific steps. The instrumental ensemble that accompanies this dance is called a Coblà.

remains very anchored, the Museum leads the discovery of musical instruments and objects originating in Africa, the Middle East, Asia, Europe and America with so much richness and musical diversity.

THE HOUSE OF WATER AND THE MEDITERRANEAN MEM is a cultural place of scientific discoveries on the theme of water which is part of the history and heritage of the town of Le Boulou. Its innovative museography emphasises the transmission of knowledge within experimental, immersive, and interactive spaces that appeal to all the senses. RECI PE BUNYETTES

INGREDIENTS

- 1 kg of flour
- 500 g caster sugar
- 125 g to 200 g butter
- 6 to 8 eggs
- Zest of 3 lemons and 3 oranges
- 9 cl of orange blossom water
- 2L of oil for frying
- 1 cube of fresh baker's yeast
- 1 pinch of salt



DID YOU KNOW ?

Bunyette time is traditionally around Palm Sunday and during Holy Week, it is an opportunity to get together with family, neighbours and / or friends to all get involved and make mountains of bunyettes with which «banastes» (containers) lined with sheets are filled.



PREPARATION

Dilute the yeast in a glass of lukewarm water. Soften the butter. Beat the eggs with the orange blossom water, zest, and salt.

Make a hill with the flour creating a well at the centre and add all the ingredients into the well.

If the dough is a little dry, add more butter, if it is too sticky add flour. After approximately 30 minutes of kneading, a yellow, smooth, and supple dough is obtained. It should come off hands and sides of the bowl. Wrap it with a floured cloth, place it in a large container near a heat source and away from drafts. Let it rest for 2 to 3 hours. It should at least triple in volume. Cut the dough and form balls about 4/5 cm in diameter.

Place a tea towel on your knee ... yes, traditionally bunyettes are stretched by hand and over the knee!

COOKING

In a frying pan, pour the oil, when it is very hot, gently place your first bunyette on the surface. When it is golden on the first side, turn it over with a fork to brown the other side. Place the bunyette on a dish, generously sweeten it. Repeat until the dough is used up.

Just before eating you can sprinkle your bunyette with a mixture of water, anisette, and orange blossom.

« Bon appétit ! »



RECIPE OF PA'D'OUS

PREPARATION

Caramelize the mould (be careful not to let the caramel brown too much!) and leave to cool. Boil the milk while adding the sugar then pour it over the beaten eggs, whisking briskly. Add the anisette or vanilla bean. Pour the cream into the caramelized, cold mould. Bake in the oven and in a bain-marie 40 minutes at 200°C.

— DID YOU KNOW ? —

The Pa'ous (egg bread) is a delicacy with a simple, authentic flavour. There are a variety of preparations out there and you probably won't find two recipes the same! But all Catalans agree that this dessert reminds us of sweet family Sundays.

INGREDIENTS

- 1L of whole milk
- 200 g caster sugar
- 80 g of sugar to caramelize the mould
- 6 whole eggs, beaten
- 3 tablespoons of anisette or 1 vanilla bean



RECIPE FOR PANELLETS

INGREDIENTS

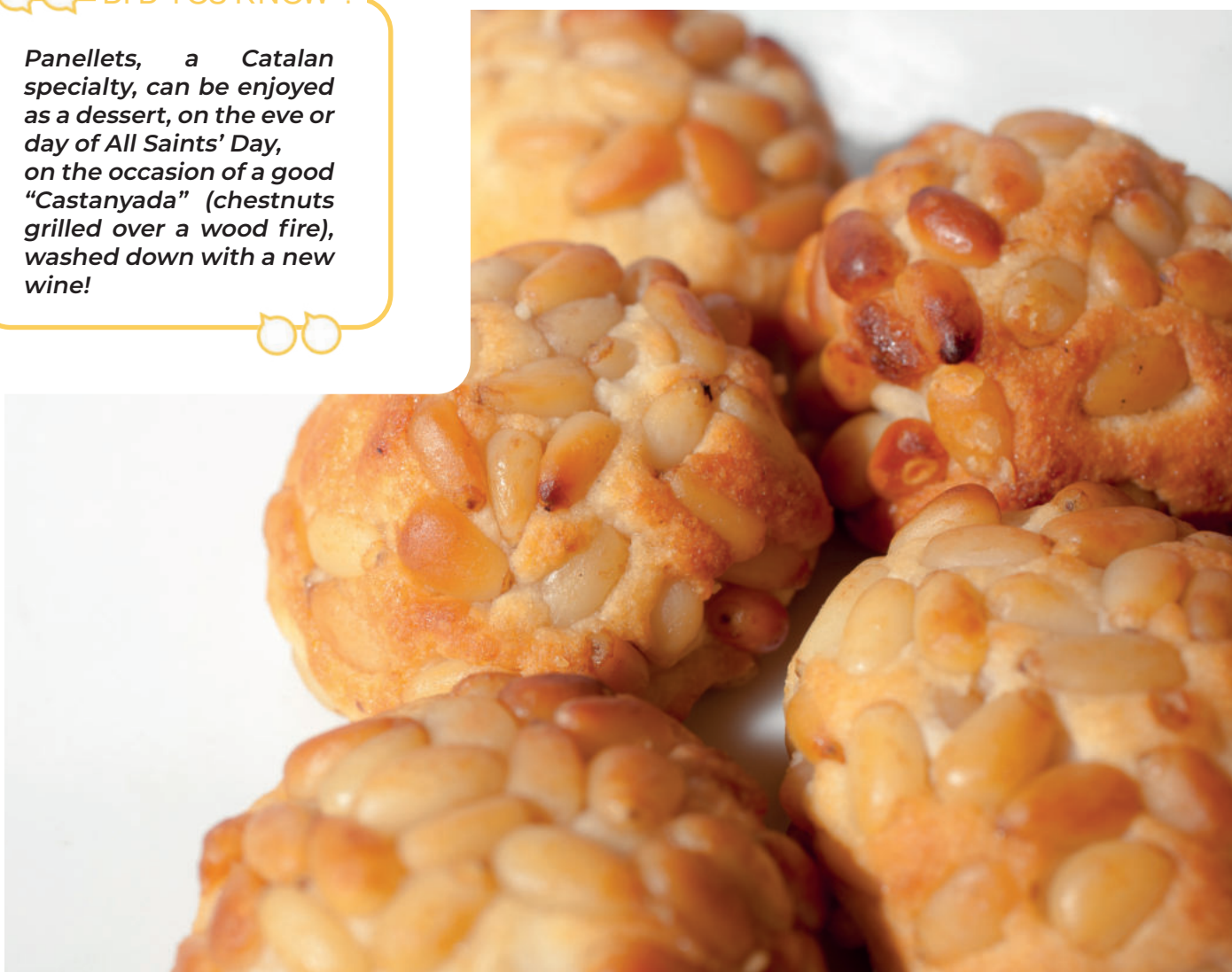
- 3 eggs + 1 yolk
- 370 g of almond powder
- 350g caster sugar
- 300g pine nuts
- 1 pinch of salt

DID YOU KNOW ?

Panellets, a Catalan specialty, can be enjoyed as a dessert, on the eve or day of All Saints' Day, on the occasion of a good "Castanyada" (chestnuts grilled over a wood fire), washed down with a new wine!

PREPARATION

Separate the egg yolks and whites.
In a bowl, beat the whites until you obtain a very frothy mixture
Add the sugar and almond powder.
Mix to obtain a paste that can be easily shaped.
Whisk the 4 egg yolks with a pinch of salt.
Take some of the dough and shape into balls the size of a walnut.
Dip each ball in the egg yolk then roll in the pine nuts.
Place the Panellets on a baking sheet covered with parchment paper.
Brush the tops of the Panellets with the remaining egg yolks.
Bake 20/25 minutes at 160 ° then leave to cool on a rack.
